## PARENT / GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Chaffey Girls Basketball strongly believes that as a parent or guardian of a player in the girls' basketball program, your actions reflect not only on you, but your child, her team, and the program.

## As a parent/guardian in the girls' basketball program, you agree to abide by and follow the rules/guidelines below:

- I understand that the use of foul language towards anyone (coaches, officials, opponents, spectators, etc.)
   will not be tolerated. I will not engage in any language or actions with the intent to initiate, hurt, intimidate, or humiliate any player, coach, official or spectator. These acts shall be considered harassment and can result in immediate removal from the game or event.
- I will not post on any social media site with the intent to initiate, hurt, intimidate, or humiliate any player, coach, official, spectator, etc. The posting of negative, demeaning, or derogatory comments will not be tolerated. As a parent, I understand that I am accountable for the actions of my child on social media sites. I will stress to my child the importance of proper conduct on these sites and provide parental oversight to prevent any type of cyber-bullying by my child.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing, complaining, taunting, or using profane language or gestures. I (and my guests) will maintain self-control at all games, and events.
- I understand that for students & coaches safety, practices are <u>closed</u> to <u>only players and coaches</u> and I will respect that rule.
- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and demonstrate positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, or event.
- I will respect all gym policies/rules (for home/away games) such as: No sitting on railings during games, no walking on the court before, during (halftime), or after games, etc. I will remain in the bleachers, along with the other spectators, during home/away games.
- I will support the coaches and allow them to do their job by not coaching my child or other players during
  games. I will not openly question or confront coaches about any concerns before, during or after games. I
  will take the time to speak with coaches about any concerns calmly, privately and at an agreed upon time
  and place.
- I understand that I, not the coaches, am responsible for my child's transportation to/from practices, before/after games, and events.
- I understand that my child is responsible for communicating with the coaches about any absences for practices, games, or events, in a timely manner. (Including any emergencies that may come about)

• I understand that my child may be subjected to removal from the program if they **do not** follow the program's policies/rules that are stated in the player contract.

## I realize that if I (or my guests) violate this Code of Conduct I/they may be subject to disciplinary action that could include one or more, but not limited to, the following:

- Verbal warning by Head Coach and/or administration
- Written warning by Head Coach and/or administration
- Parental/quest game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by administration
- Parental/quest season suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by administration
- Parental/guest suspension from all future Chaffey Girls Basketball Games (Home or Away), or events, with written documentation of incident kept on file by administration
